WHAT HAS BEEN AGREED SO FAR?

- HS2 Ltd letter of agreement with WCC – settled “out of court”
- Agreed to build a new Water Orton Primary School – £3.5m towards costs
- Traffic Management System on A446

TIMESCALES

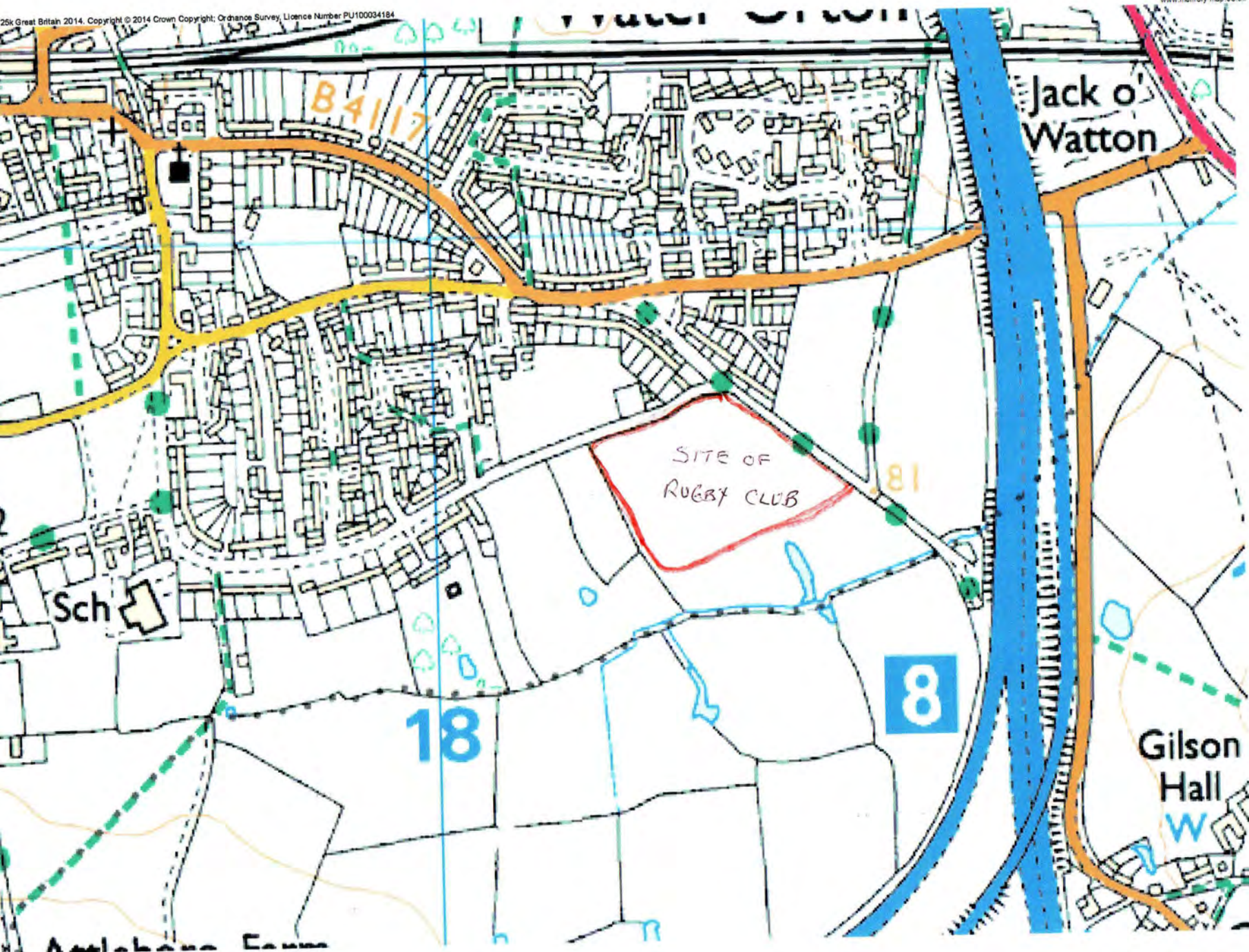
- 1900 Petitions to be heard and acted on – at least another 12months
- Third reading of Hybrid Bill to be passed by House of Commons
- Petitions to House of Lords
- Royal Assent given and work can start – 2016?
- WCC to find suitable site to build new school
- HS2 Ltd to compulsory purchase land and transfer £3.5m to WCC
- New school constructed (38 weeks) by 2018
- No work to be done on HS2 Lines until children have moved to new school
- HS2 construction to begin end 2018 for at least 5yrs
- Trains into service – 2026
- Y Junction and Phase II to commence about 2027

WHAT WILL HAPPEN TO OLD SCHOOL SITE

- WCC to retain ownership of land
- Nothing done until HS2 Construction Phase is completed – Probably 2022
- Land likely to be sold to property developers as a brownfield site
- What sort of properties?

THE RUGBY CLUB

- Existing Club and pitches to be demolished
- New site to be found
- HS2 Ltd to pay for complete removal to new site including new clubhouse, car park & pitches
- At least 2years to consolidate new pitches

OBJECTIVES OF GROUP WITH VILLAGE APPROVAL

- Ensure we have an input to the New School Plans
- We want a substantial Car Park at the New School (100 spaces)
- Plank Lane may need to be widened
- Same area of playing fields and playgrounds as old school
- Do not want a high rise block – 2 stories max
- Vehicle access not via Mickle Meadow
- **MUST RETAIN VICTORIAN BUILDINGS OF OLD SCHOOL**
uses could be – Heritage Centre (Colin Green our historian)
Badminton Club
Keep Fit Club
Whilst Drives
Village Meetings
Educational – Computer Lessons for over 60' s etc.
